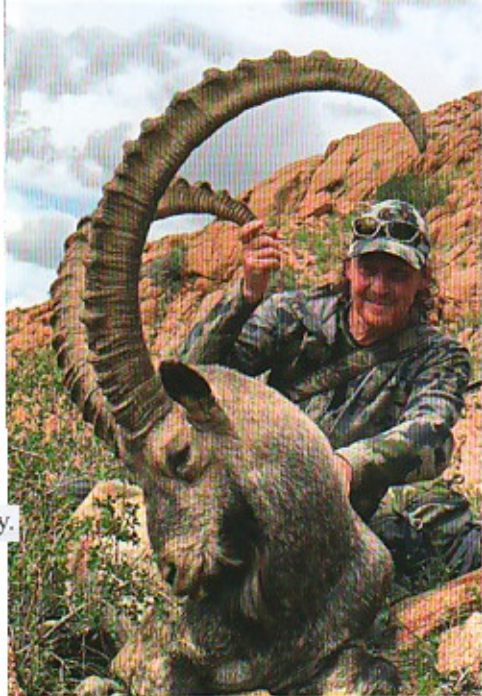


Connie De Jong (Netherlands) had this to say about his recent Altay ibex hunt with ProfiHunt:

The Altay ibex is the 17th species toward my Capra Super 20. After my wife **Debby Smits** took a great ibex out of a group of 68 animals, we found this group again after several hours of climbing and searching. After a long stalk I got in position for a shot at 400 meters on a nice billy that was lying down in a group of five animals. We moved around the mountain to come a little bit closer and get a better shooting position. When it was less windy, I took a shot at the billy, which had stood up. Unfortunately, the shot hit the billy too far back and I needed a second shot to finish the job. I was very happy with this 10-year-old billy. We had a great hunt. The organization was perfect, the people were very kind and helpful. We couldn't wish for more. After the Altay ibex, we went to the Gobi area for another ibex for Debby.
