

Alexey Kim (Russia) traveled to Turkey in November 2019 where he took an Anatolian chamois with **Diamond Supporter ProfiHunt**:

In November my wife Angela and I flew to Istanbul then transferred to Erzurum. We were met at the airport by Rasim. It took us four hours to reach the hunting area although the distance was only 120 km. Half of the trip was on a winding mountain road. We arrived at base camp and shot the rifle to make sure it was still on. Within an hour we were hunting and not far from the road found a group of chamois that had a good male. Since it was early in the hunt and the rut was on, I decided not to shoot.

We hunted for five days and saw many females and young males but never found a large trophy. On the seventh day we were lucky. Our guide Yashar spotted two great males above us at the top of the mountain. We began to climb closer to them, but they disappeared. After about 20 minutes, we suddenly saw them running down the stream toward us. I fired twice but missed. Yashar whistled and the male stopped. When he did, I managed to range the distance and make an accurate shot with the Blaser R8 in .300 Win. Mag. We had incredible luck and I got my Anatolian chamois.
